- BVV Pensionsfonds des Bankgewerbes AG (pension fund⁴)

BVV was founded as a mutual company called "Beamtenversicherungsverein des deutschen Bank-und Bankiergewerbes" on July 11, 1909. A century later, BVV is a consistent provider for a company pension plan in the domain of bank and financial services. In numbers (as of 31.12.2017):

- More than 114,000 recipients of benefits
- Round about 28.1 billion Euro in assets under management
